## CESAR CHAVEZ

An activist for civil rights, Cesar Chavez (1927- 1993) was a Mexican American farmer and stood against labor issues in America. He co-founded the United Farm Workers Association and eventually became the most well-known Latino American civil rights activist in the United States. Since his death in 1993, Cesar Chavez has remained an iconic symbol of support for Hispanic workers and the Latino community.
